Assumptions

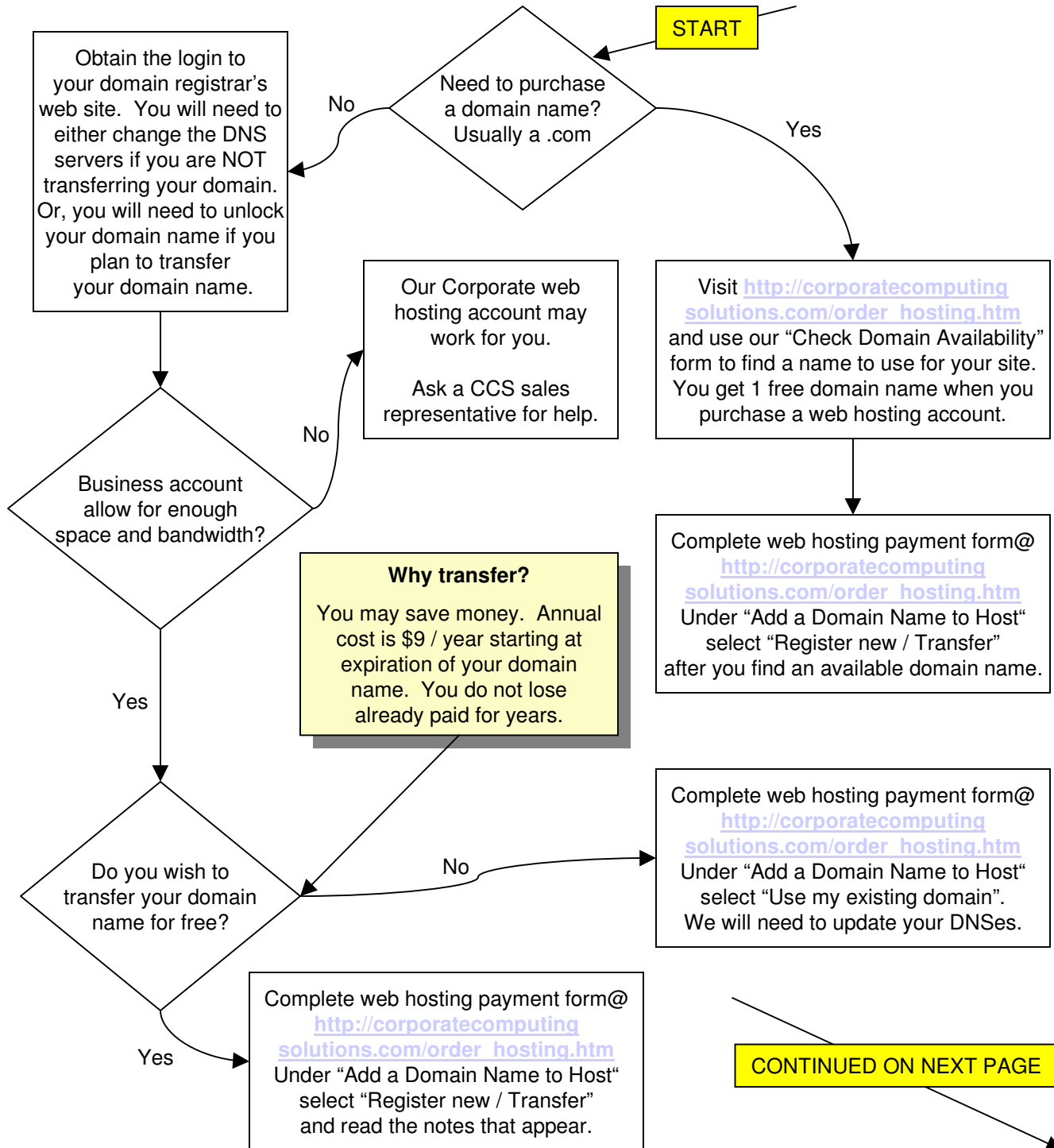
- Planning to host web site through Corporate Computing Solutions, LLC.
